VANCOUVER ROCKERS STATE OF SHOCK RECEIVE JUNO AWARD NOMINATION

Vancouver, BC – Things just keep getting better and better for **State of Shock**! The Vancouver rock band was thrilled this week when they found themselves nominated for a 2008 Juno Award in the Best New Group category along with fellow Canadians Dragonette, Faber Drive, Ill Scarlett and Wintersleep. The Juno Award nomination caps off an amazing 2007 for **State of Shock** and adds to their many other award nominations, including 1 nomination for a 2007 Western Canadian Music Award, 1 nomination for an Indie Music Award and 3 nominations for Canadian Radio Music Awards held the upcoming Canadian Music Week 2008 in Toronto.

State of Shock have experienced incredible success thus far with their first album on Cordova Bay Records, *Life, Love + Lies*. Since it's release in June 2007, **State of Shock** have had a Top Ten single at 3 radio formats (Rock, CHR and Hot AC) with the infectious "*Money Honey*" and are already seeing their second single "*Hearts That Bleed*" approach Top 10 at Canadian Rock Radio this week and is poised to cross over to other formats. The band has also had great success and support from the nation's music station MUCH MUSIC. **State of Shock** appeared on the daily show "MUCH on Demand" last week and are receiving heavy rotation on MUCH with the new "*Hearts That Bleed*" video. And it doesn't end there. **State of Shock** has surpassed platinum status for the digital sales of "*Money Honey*" with over 51,000 sold to date.

State of Shock are currently on the road with fellow rockers Hedley performing at Kingston FebFest on February 8th and then Surrey Winter Festival this Saturday, February 9th.
